

# FLAG ES/MS/HS Spoken Language Contests 2017

Dear Foreign Language Educators:

As you may be aware, the **2017 FLAG SLCs** are coming soon! The Middle and High School Spoken Language Contests will be held on Saturday, March 25 at Cambridge High School in Milton; Saturday, April 1 at Islands High School in Savannah; and Saturday, April 8 at Deerfield-Windsor School in Albany. The Elementary School contests will be held on Saturday, April 1 at Islands HS in Savannah; and Saturday, April 29 at Evansdale ES in DeKalb County.

We have developed a new registration process for all contests and will be going live **Wednesday, February 1.**

### IMPORTANT CHANGES TO THE PROCESS:

- Teachers and/or students will register electronically by going to [FLAG'S SPOKEN LANGUAGE CONTEST WEBSITE](#).
- Electronic payment will be due at the time of registration.
- Only one participant can be registered at a time.
- Registrants will receive a confirmation email/form which they will present the day of the contest.
- Judges will register at a separate link

Since many judges are needed to make these contests successful, we are requiring each school to send at least one judge. Schools sending more than 7 students should send at least one judge for each 7 students. Each school may send 3 students per language per level. This will ensure we have enough judges the day of the contest. Judges and sponsoring teachers must be FLAG members.
